- Basic Millinery techniques, such as working with sinamay one of the main fabrics used in Millinery.
- Using stripping to create sculptural organic pieces associated with your form objects.
- Creating bases to work from which you will learn how to put a nice finish on your piece whether it be rolled or a bias bound finish for a professional look.
- Working with Millinery wire, learning how to manipulate feathers
- Mounting your pieces on a comb, headband or base with elastic and much more.

What you need to bring?

Your materials such as Sinamay and feathers etc will be provided on the day and the cost is included in the total cost of the course.

Extra items that you wish to bring on the day are as follows:

- Assortment of hand sewing needles
- Pins
- Fabric Scissors
- Thimble and chalk
- Threads
- Any pictures or ideas you might have of what you would like to work on.
- Trimmings varying on your ideas but bring as much bits and pieces if you think you could incorporate in your piece like craft wire, beads, ribbons etc
- Hair Curling Tongs (only if you have one)
- If you think you could be sensitive to sinamay as it is a coarse fabric, bring some gloves!
